

SHALOM LODGE CAPITAL CAMPAIGN

At Camp Shalom, our Vision Statement guides us:

"Camp Shalom's purpose is to be a community of many Christian traditions nurturing faith among God's people. Offering a safe, nurturing, Christ-centered summer camp for youth and families, Camp Shalom will enrich the lives of its campers and staff."

Since 1976, we have viewed this vision as a commitment to providing a spiritually fulfilling, safe, and enriching experience for our campers.

Thanks to the support of generations, Camp Shalom has grown and improved its facilities. We now seek your assistance with our latest project, which aims to enhance our ability to ensure a safe and healthy environment for everyone.

We have already raised half of the funds needed and have begun constructing a multipurpose building. This new facility will expand our healthcare capabilities, offer secure shelter during severe weather or other emergencies, provide summer staff housing, and accommodate retreat events.

We are down to the last \$90,000 needed complete this much needed structure and complete the capital campaign. We invite you to contribute to this significant improvement and thank you for supporting the transformative mission of Camp Shalom.

The Shalom Lodge Capital Campaign will provide support several key improvements:

- Health Care Center: With increasing healthcare needs at camp, the new building will feature office space for healthcare operations and areas to care for campers who require isolation for health reasons. This new space will also be more comforting to campers with mental health issues.
- Retreat Facility: The facility will accommodate small-group retreats with room for up to 24 people, sleeping 12 people on each floor. The buildings main gathering space will be 28'x28' with a vaulted ceiling. The main room will also include a kitchenette. The building will have heating and air conditioning for year-round use.
- Staff Housing: The original staff house, used for both sleeping quarters and office space, was deemed unsalvageable and has been removed to make room for the new facility. The new facility will provide dedicated spaces for staff housing and other activities, including professional tasks
- Safe Storm Shelter: To enhance safety during severe weather, the lower level of the new building will include concrete-walled emergency shelter areas, providing a secure space for campers and staff.
